ENTRIES CLOSE – SUNDAY 28th JULY 2024

Lemon Curd & Blueberry Loaf

Ingredients

175g / 6oz softened butter

100g Greek yogurt

2 tablespoons lemon curd

3 eggs

Zest & juice of 1 lemon plus extra for decoration

200g / 7oz Self Raising Flour

175g / 6oz caster sugar

100 g blueberries

140g / 5oz icing sugar

edible flowers e.g. purple or yellow primroses to decorate

Method

Oven 160C / 140C fan / gas 3

Grease 2 x 1lb loaf tins and line with a long strip of baking parchment.

Put the butter, yogurt, lemon curd, eggs, lemon zest, flour and caster sugar into a large bowl.

Mix well with an electric whisk until the mixture comes together.

Divide half the mixture between the 2 tins. Divide the blueberries and scatter half over the mixture.

Divide the remaining mixture between the tins and scatter the remaining berries over the top.

Bake approx. 45 – 60 min. Allow to cool in the tins.

Sift the icing sugar into a bowl and add enough lemon juice to make a thick, smooth icing.

Spread over the cake and decorate with lemon zest and edible flowers.

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
